Morse code is a method of communicating text information as a series of on-off sounds ('dots and dashes'), that can be directly understood by a skilled listener without special equipment.


You can practice Morse code by writing the dots and dashes to replace the letters of the alphabet. When writing Morse code you use a / to separate each letter so the other person can understand your message.









For example: To say "Hello" your message would look like this:
