MESSAGES

Morse code is a method of communicating text information as a series of on-off sounds ('dots and dashes'), that can be directly understood by a skilled listener without special equipment.

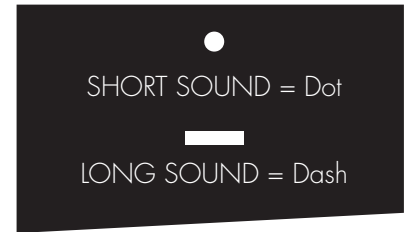
