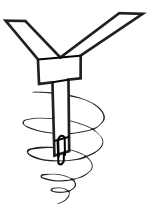
ROTO-COPTER

what you'll need

- Scissors
- Paperclip
- Colouring pencils (optional)

instructions

1. Cut along the solid black lines 
2. Fold the bottom flap up along the dotted lines. 
3. Then fold along the vertical dotted lines, pressing the flaps backwards.
4. Fold the two rotor blades of the helicopter, at the top, in opposite directions. 
5. Decorate! 
6. Attach a paperclip to the bottom of the helicopter for extra weight. 
7. Hold your Roto-Copter by the paperclip, and throw your helicopter up as high as you can (or drop it from a safe height) and watch it fly through the air.



- Can you make a target for your Roto-Copter to land on?
- Can you make your own smaller version? Does it fly differently to this one?
